- **Help Maintain, A Regular Schedule.**

- **Set Time Weekly To Study Over Important Assignments, Quizzes.**

Have This Tips In Mind.

- **Have Educator's Provide Clear, Specific Directions.**
- **Educator Communicates Often With Parent, Student.**
- **Educator Can, Provided Assignments Ahead Of Time For Preview.**
- **Provided Repetition Of Content Using Multiple Modalities For Input.**
- **Providing Instructions, Videos, Or Screen Shots Of The Lessons.**
- **Break Down Instructions Content Into Smaller Segments .**
- **Help Your Student Keep A Log Of Upcoming Online Conferences With Date, And Times. This Can, Included; Assignments Due Date, Quizzes , Test Dates.**
- **For Children With Memory Or Cognitive, Impairments. Provided A Calendar With Visuals. Use Color Coding , Stickers, Markers.**
- **Prior To The Lesson Parent, Encourage Student, To Write Concerns, Questions For Educator.**
- **Teach Child To Check Calendar Daily.**
- **Set Regular Time To Check And Discuss Your Child's Work.**
- **Ask Questions Regularly To Your Child Of What Work It's Most Challenging.**
- **Work On Taking Frequent Breaks Go Outside Throw A Ball, Play With Pet.**
- **Will Help Your Child With Coping With Frustration.**
- **Managing Stress Will Help In Making Other Work Lest Challenging.**
- **Mental Emotional Health It Most Important, Have Fun With Your Child.**
- **Keep Tabs On How Much Time Your Child Its Speeding Working , Playing With Electronics. To Much Screen Time Can Lead To Depression, Trouble Sleeping, Moodiness.**
